Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

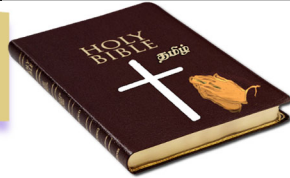

SAINTS OF THE DAY

July 14

Kateri Tekakwitha Died in 1680 in Quebec at age 24; led a life of great austerity and love in spite of ridicule and abuse; called "Lily of the Mohawks"; first native American to be declared "Blessed"; canonized in 2012.

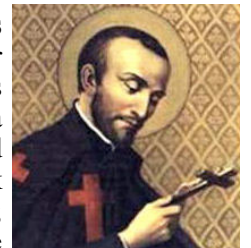


July 15 **Bonaventure** Died in 1274; minister general for 17 years; Cardinal bishop of Albano; authored biblical commentaries and many ascetical and spiritual treatises; doctor of the Church.

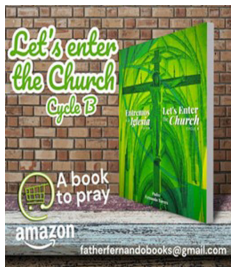
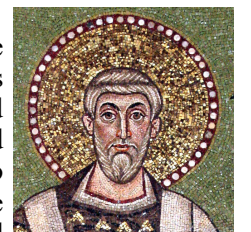


July 16 **Our Lady of Carmel** The scriptures speak of the beauty of Mount Carmel in Galilee where the prophet Elijah defended the faith of Israel in the living God.

July 18 **Camillus de Lellis** Died in 1614 in Rome; soldier addicted to gambling; his conversion led him to found a society that established hospitals and cared for the sick with affection and diligence; priest; patron of nurses, of the sick and of hospitals.



July 20 **Apollinaris** Died in the 1st century; early accounts report that he was ordained bishop by St. Peter himself and sent as a missionary bishop to Ravenna during the reign of the emperor Claudius; renowned for his power to heal in the name of Christ, he was frequently exiled, tortured and imprisoned for the faith and finally martyred.

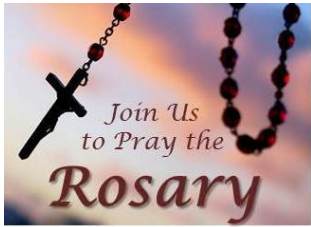


PARISH COMMUNICATION

Rosary

The Rosary is a biblical prayer, developed as we know it from the Middle Ages. It developed out of an ancient practice in which people who could not read Scripture recited 150 Our Father's in honor of the 150 psalms. Strings of beads were used to keep track.

Today we meditate on the lives of Christ and Mary using the words of the Angel Gabriel recited to Mary. The Rosary is the most powerful weapon to touch the heart of Jesus, Our redeemer, who loves His Mother and all of us.

May we be given the grace to heed Padre Pio's admonition: "Love Our Lady, make others love her. Always say your Rosary and say it well."

Join us every **Monday at 12:10pm in the Chapel** to pray the rosary.

If you can't join us, then say The Rosary Daily as a family. The family that prays together stays together.



COME TO ADORATION

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." - Mt 11:28

In our self-centered culture and classic American emphasis on work, we often feel we have to accomplish something during our times of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. We rate our experience by how 'good' our prayer was, how heartfelt our devotion was, or how focused we could remain. Yet prayer and contemplation are fundamentally God's work, in which we are invited to participate. We need only to give Him the opening, and He will do the rest. If we can take the time to pull away from the busyness and distractions of life and just sit at His feet, He will lead us.

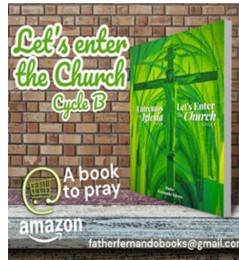
