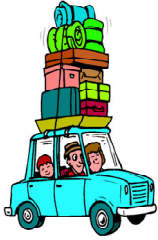

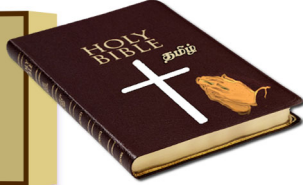

SAINTS OF THE DAY



July 29 — Mary, Martha, and Lazarus
On January 26, 2021, Pope

Francis ordered the inscription **Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus** into the General Roman Calendar, to replace the existing celebration of Saint Martha alone. They died in the 1st century; In the household of Bethany, the Lord Jesus experienced the family spirit and friendship of Martha, Mary and Lazarus, and for this reason the Gospel of John states that he loved them. Martha generously offered him hospitality, Mary listened attentively to his words and Lazarus promptly emerged from the tomb at the command of the one who humiliated death.

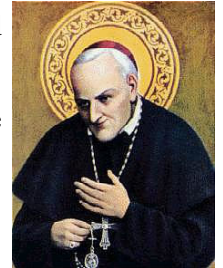
July 30 — Peter Chrysologus Died around 450; called “Chrysologus”, meaning “of golden speech” for his exceptional preaching ability; 170 homilies are extant; bishop of Ravenna.



July 31 — Ignatius of Loyola Died in 1556; soldier; founded the Roman College; authored the *Spiritual Exercises*; founded the *Compañia de Jesús*; patron saint of retreatants and soldiers.



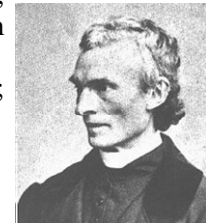
Aug 1 Alphonsus Liguori Died in 1787; lawyer; founded the Redemptorists; opposed Jansenism, stressing Christ’s love and Mary’s intercession; bishop of Saint’ Agata dei Goti; master of moral theology; patron of confessors and moral theologians.



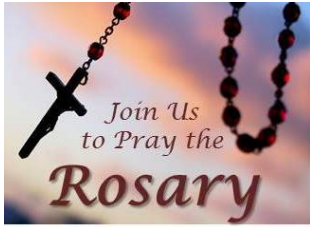
Aug 2 Eusebius of Vercelli Died in 371; considered the founder of the canons regular in the West; defender of St. Athanasius; exiled to Palestine by Constantius; opponent of Arianism.



Aug 2 Peter Julian Eymard Died in 1868; born in France in 1811; founded the



Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament which is devoted to the worship and apostolate of the Eucharist as the center of the life of the Church and society.



Rosary

The Rosary is at heart a biblical prayer, developed as we know it from the

Middle Ages. It developed out of an ancient practice in which people who could not read Scripture recited 150 Our Father's in honor of the 150 psalms. Strings of beads were used to keep track.

Today we meditate on the lives of Christ and Mary using the words of the Angel Gabriel recited to Mary. The Rosary is the most powerful weapon to touch the heart of Jesus, Our redeemer, who loves His Mother and all of us.

May we be given the grace to heed Padre Pio's admonition: "Love Our Lady, make others love her. Always say your Rosary and say it well."

Join us every **Monday at 12:10pm in the Chapel** to pray the rosary.

If you can't join us, then say The Rosary Daily as a family. The family that prays together stays together.

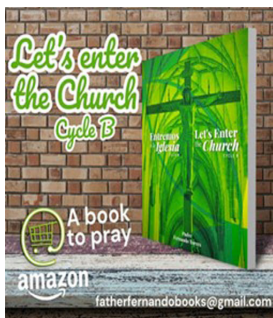
