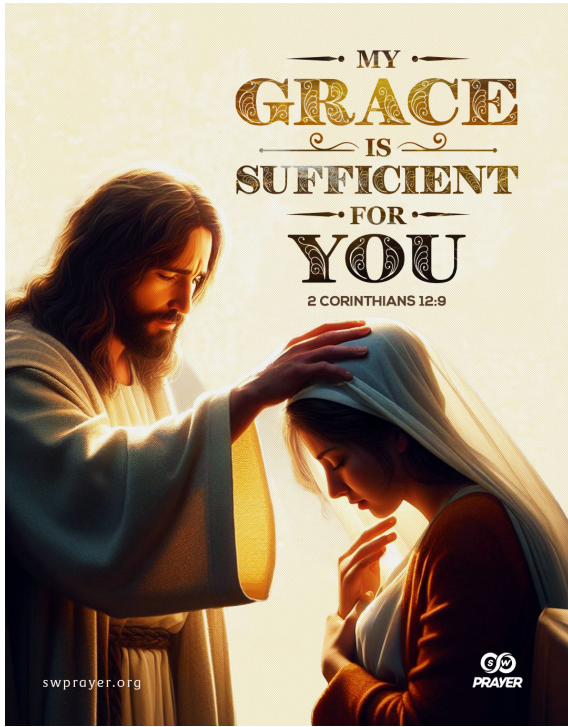

#### New Parishioners

Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

#### Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

#### Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

#### Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

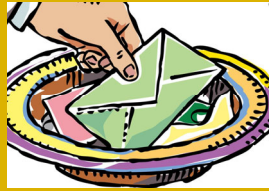

**IMPORTANT NOTICE: Effective January 1, 2025 the cost for a niche in the columbarium will increased to \$4000.**



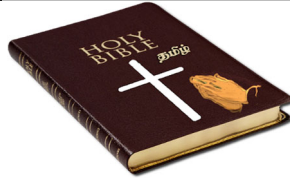
### Altar Server Recognition

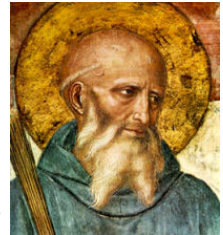
SAINTS OF THE DAY

July 9 **Augustine Zhao Rong and companions** Died between 1648 and 1930;

120 martyrs; most born in China; age ranging from 9 to 72; Augustine Zhao Rong was a Chinese soldier who accompanied the prisoner Bishop John Gabriel Taurin Dufresse to his martyrdom in Beijing; moved by the bishop's courage, Augustine sought baptism and not long after was ordained a diocesan priest; he was martyred in 1815.



July 11 **Benedict** Died in 547; wrote famous monastic Rule noted for its wisdom and moderation, and need for obedience; founded 12 monasteries; considered the "Patriarch of Western Monasticism"; a patron of Europe.



July 13 **Henry** Died in 1024; together with his wife, St. Cunegunda, he assisted the poor; as emperor, he respected the Church's freedom, fostering ecclesiastical and monastic reform; patron of Benedictine oblates.

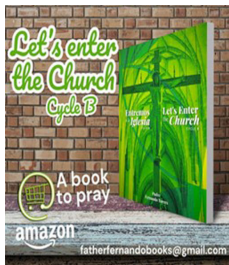

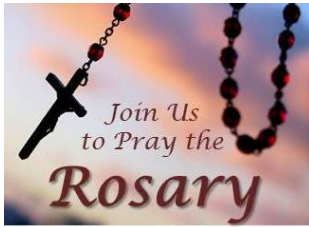
**PARISH COMMUNICATION**

**Rosary**

The Rosary is a biblical prayer, developed as we know it from the Middle Ages. It developed out of an ancient practice in which people who could not read Scripture recited 150 Our Father's in honor of the 150 psalms. Strings of beads were used to keep track.

Today we meditate on the lives of Christ and Mary using the words of the Angel Gabriel recited to Mary. The Rosary is the most powerful weapon to touch the heart of Jesus, Our redeemer, who loves His Mother and all of us.

May we be given the grace to heed Padre Pio's admonition: "Love Our Lady, make others love her. Always say your Rosary and say it well."

Join us every **Monday at 12:10pm in the Chapel** to pray the rosary.

If you can't join us, then say The Rosary Daily as a family. The family that prays together stays together.



**COME TO ADORATION**

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." - Mt 11:28

In our self-centered culture and classic American emphasis on work, we often feel we have to accomplish something during our times of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. We rate our experience by how 'good' our prayer was, how heartfelt our devotion was, or how focused we could remain. Yet prayer and contemplation are fundamentally God's work, in which we are invited to participate. We need only to give Him the opening, and He will do the rest. By coming to adoration, we are handing Him the keys to our hearts, allowing the rays of His love and grace to bathe our souls in the light of His Presence, as the rays of the sun bathe our bodies in light. If we can take the time to pull away from the busyness and distractions of life and just sit at His feet, He will lead us.

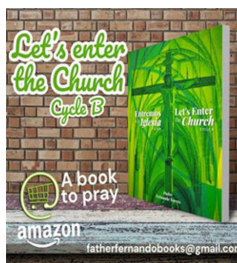
