It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

**Sacrament of Baptism**  
Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

**Sacrament of Matrimony**  
Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

**Sacrament of Anointing**  
The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

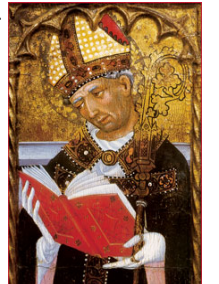
**SAINTS OF THE DAY**



**June 19 Romuald** Died in 1027; founded the Camaldolese hermits; urged contemplative prayer through solitude, silence and fasting.



**June 21 Aloysius Gonzaga** Died in 1591 at the age of 23 caring for the sick; from the princely family of Castiglione; renounced inheritance to enter the Jesuits; strongly devoted to the Eucharist, interior prayer and charitable service; patron of youth and of students in Jesuit colleges and universities.

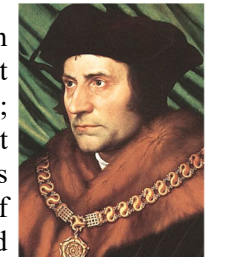


**June 22 Paulinus of Nola** Died in 431; husband and father who gave his possessions to the poor; dedicated bishop.

**June 22 John Fisher** Died in 1535; was beheaded; chancellor of Cambridge University; bishop of Rochester; dedicated pastor of souls; renowned for his preaching and educational reforms; defender of Church tradition against Luther, and of the Roman primacy against Henry VIII.



**June 22 Thomas More** Died in 1535; was beheaded; humanist and chancellor of England; wrote *Utopia*; refused to support Henry VIII's divorce and his Act of Supremacy; patron of lawyers, statesmen and politicians.

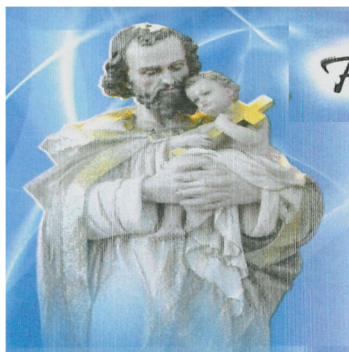

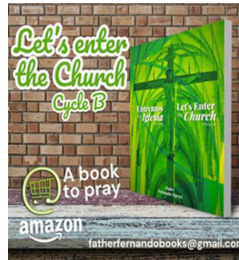
