It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

**Sacrament of Baptism**

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

**Sacrament of Matrimony**

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

**Sacrament of Anointing**

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

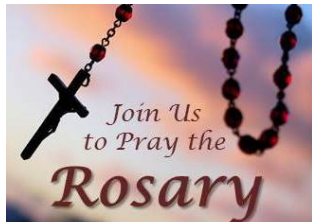

Knights, parishioners, and friends of parishioners are welcome to attend. Last year's event drew 75 participants.

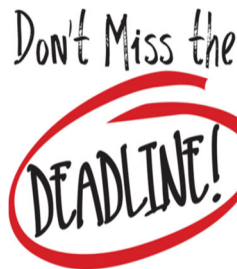

**PLEASE NOTE: Godparent forms need to be signed IN THE PRESENCE OF A CATHOLIC PRIEST.**

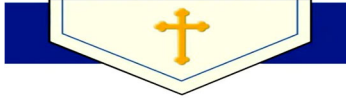

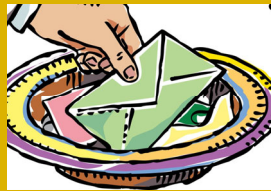

**Columbarium**

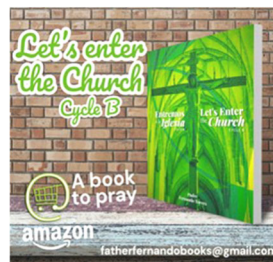

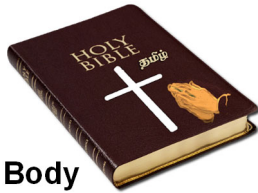

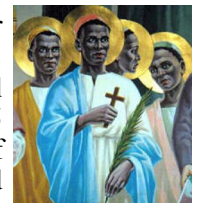

SAINTS OF THE DAY

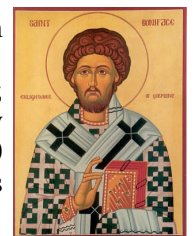


**June 2 Marcellinus and Peter** Died around 303; Marcellinus was a presbyter; Peter was an exorcist; beheaded under Diocletian.

**June 3 Charles Lwanga and companions** Died between 1885 and 1887; proto-martyrs of Black Africa; over one hundred killed in this period; patron saint of African Catholic Youth Action.



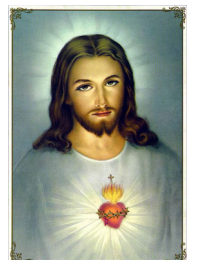
**June 5 Boniface** Died in 754; bishop of Mainz; founded abbey of Fulda; martyred along with 30 companions in Frisia; known as the “Apostle of Germany.”



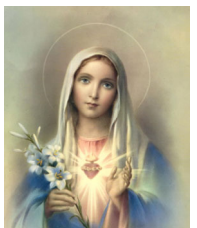
**June 6 Norbert** Died in 1134; founded the Premonstratensians; archbishop of Magdeburg; strong supporter of Church reform and evangelization; devoted to the holy eucharist.



**June 7 Sacred Heart of Jesus** First celebrated on August 31, 1670, in France; the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque made it universal; in these June 16, 1675 visions Jesus appeared and asked St. Margaret Mary to request that the Feast of the Sacred Heart be celebrated on the Friday after the octave of the Feast of Corpus Christi, in reparation for the ingratitude of men for the sacrifice that Christ had made for them. The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents not simply His physical heart but His love for all mankind.



**June 8 Immaculate Heart of Mary** is a name used to refer to the interior life of the Blessed Virgin Mary, her joys and sorrows, her virtues and hidden perfections, and, above all, her virginal love for God the Father, her maternal love for her son Jesus, and her compassionate love for all persons.

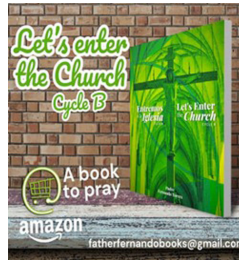

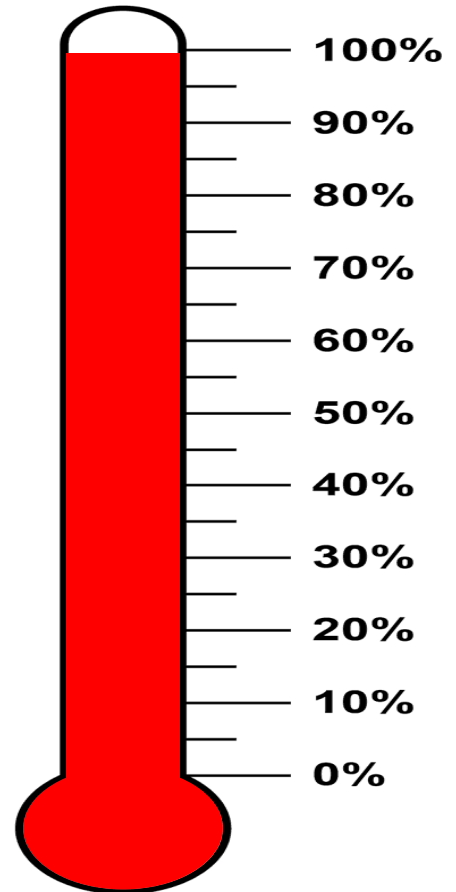
