### Sacrament of Baptism

### Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

### Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

Our next class is November 10.

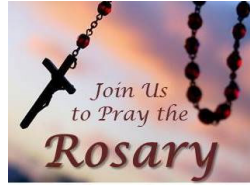
Pre-registration at least a week in advance is required.

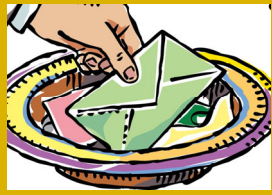

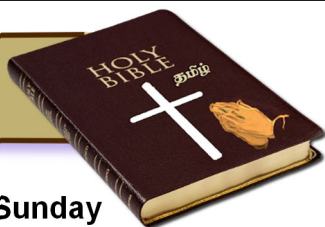

**SAINTS OF THE DAY**

**Nov 3 Martin de Porres** Died in 1639; born in Lima of a Spanish father and a black slave mother; OP lay brother who humbly ministered to the poor and the sick, especially African slaves; devoted to the Holy Eucharist; patron of social justice and of peoples of mixed races.



**Nov 4 Charles Borromeo** Died in 1584 at age 46; cardinal and secretary of state at age 22 for his uncle, Pope Pius IV; implemented reforms of Trent in his diocese of Milan; founder of seminaries; held 5 provincial councils and 11 diocesan synods; patron of catechists and of catechumens.



**Nov 9 Dedication of the  
Lateran Basilica**

Anniversary of the dedication in 324 of the cathedral church of Rome, on land owned by the Laterani family; honored as the episcopal seat of the pope as bishop of Rome, it is the “mother and head of all churches of Rome and the world”; residence of the popes from the 4<sup>th</sup> century until 1309; site of five ecumenical councils; dedicated to the Savior, later to John the Baptist.

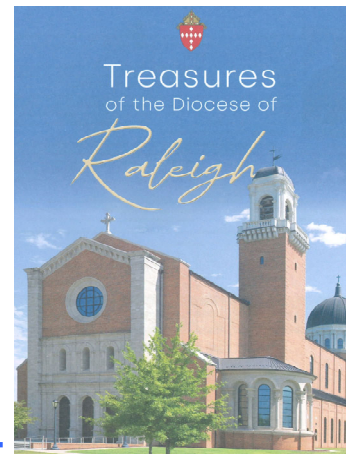
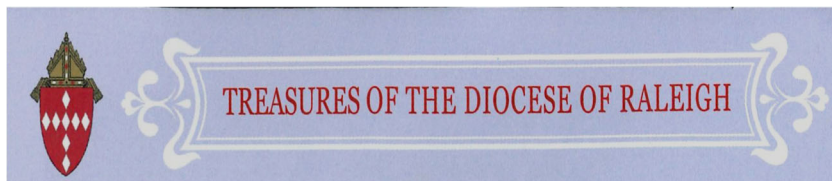

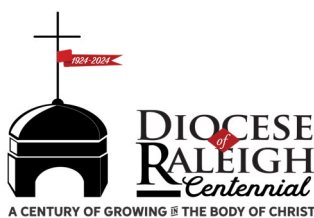
