It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

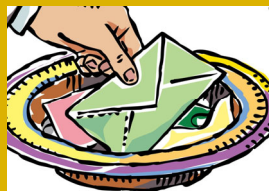

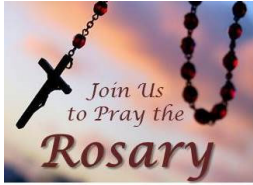

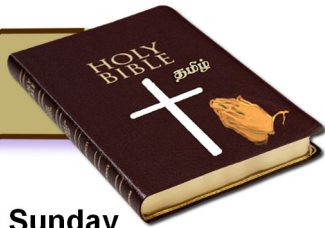
Courage / Encourage

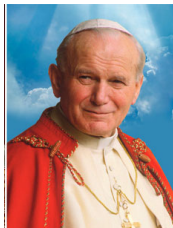

SAINTS OF THE DAY



Oct 20 Paul of the Cross Died in 1775; renowned preacher and founder of the Passionists, today numbering 2,200 members, who combine the apostolate of retreats and missions with penitential monasticism.



Oct 22 John Paul II Died in 2005; born in 1920 in Wadowice, Poland; as archbishop of Krakow took part in Second Vatican Council; elected Pope in 1978; his exceptional zeal, particularly for families, young people and the sick, led him to make numerous pastoral visits throughout the world; he left a rich Magisterium and the Code of Canon Law for the Latin Church and Eastern Churches, and the third typical edition of the *Roman Missal*; canonized in 2014.



Oct 23 John Capistrano Died in 1456; priest; reformer of the Franciscans and Poor Clares; preached devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus; sought an end to the Western Schism; animated resistance against the Turks at the battle of Belgrade; patron of military chaplains.



Oct 24 Anthony Mary Claret Died in 1870; vigorous reforming bishop of Santiago, Cuba; founded the Missionary Sons of the Immaculate Heart of Mary; fostered credit unions and the apostolate of the press.

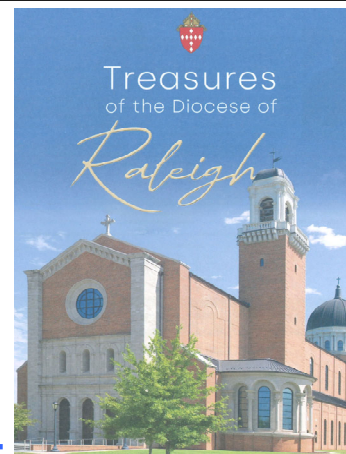
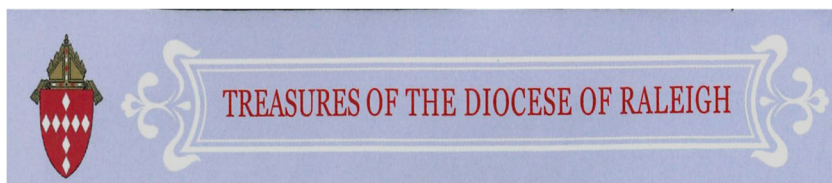

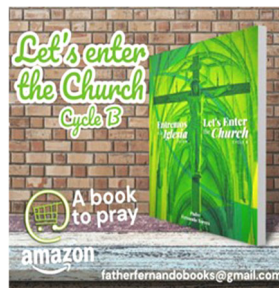
