It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

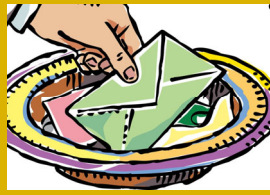

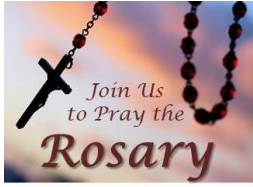

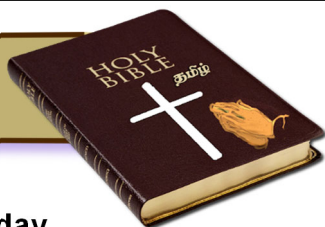
Courage / Encourage

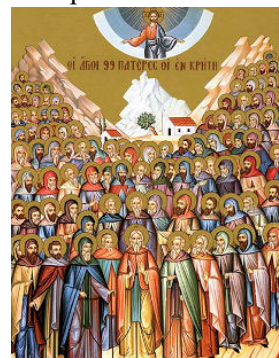

SAINTS OF THE DAY



Oct 28 Simon and Jude Died in first century; Simon called “the Canaanite” and “the Zealot”, an anti-Roman party; possibly preached in Egypt and Persia. Jude, or Thaddeus may have preached in Palestine and Persia; patron of those in despair, or

in hopeless situations.



Nov 1 All Saints Day First mentioned in the 4th century Eastern feast of All Martyrs (May 13) and attested to by St. Ephrem of Edessa, this feast came to be celebrated on other days as well in the East (e.g., Easter Friday and the Sunday after Pentecost, the day of its observance in some places in the West.) In 609 or 610, the Roman

Pantheon was dedicated on May 13 under the title *S. Maria and Martyres*. Many see in this the origin of All Saints Day. For reasons which are unclear, Pope Gregory IV (827-844) transferred the feast from May to November 1, adopting perhaps the English-Gallican practice dating from the first quarter of the 8th century.

Nov 2 Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (All Souls’ Day) Rooted in ancient Christian tradition (2nd century and Tertullian), St. Odilo of Cluny established a memorial of all the faithful departed in 988. It was accepted in Rome in the 13th century.
