### Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

### Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

### Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

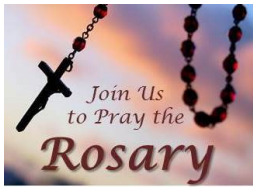

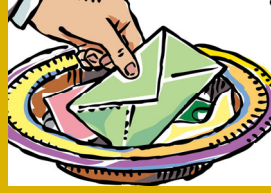

**SAINTS OF THE DAY**



**Sept 23 Pius of Pietrelcina** Died in 1968 at age 81; known as Padre Pio; born in Italy; Capuchin priest who had received the stigmata; sought after as spiritual advisor, confessor and intercessor; devoted to the Eucharist and prayer; patron of civil defense volunteers and Catholic adolescents.



**Sept 26 Cosmas and Damian** Died around 300 in Syria; brother physicians known as “moneyless ones” for their gratuitous care of the sick; patrons of physicians, surgeons, druggists, barbers and the blind.



**Sept 27 Vincent de Paul** Died in 1660 in Paris; renewed the clergy and defended the poor and the abandoned; founded the Congregation of the Missions; preached against Jansenism; patron of charities, hospitals, prisoners and of Madagascar.



**Sept 28 Wenceslaus** Died in 929 at age 22; duke of Bohemia; sought to bring the faith to his people; killed by his pagan brother, Boleslaus; patron of the Czech Republic and Slovakia.

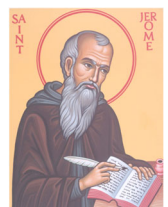


**Sept 28 Lawrence Ruiz and companions** Died between 1633 and 1637; 16 were martyred in Nagasaki, Japan; one was Filipino, Lawrence Ruiz, the father of a family and protomartyr of the Philippines; after enduring horrible tortures, their bodies

were burned and their ashes scattered by order of the Japanese ruler.



**Sept 29 Michael, Gabriel and Raphael** Archangels; these biblical messengers signify God’s transcendence and loving care; Michael means “Who is like God?”, Gabriel means “God’s Strength” and Raphael means “God’s Remedy”; Michael is the patron of security forces and of the sick; Gabriel is the patron of telecommunications and the postal service; Raphael is the patron of travelers and the blind.



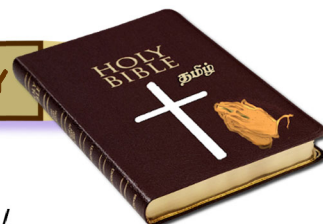
**Sept 30 Jerome** Died in 420 at Bethlehem; devoted monk and ascetic; wrote numerous commentaries on and authored Latin “Vulgate” translation of the Bible; priest; one of the four great doctors of the Latin Church; patron of scripture scholars.

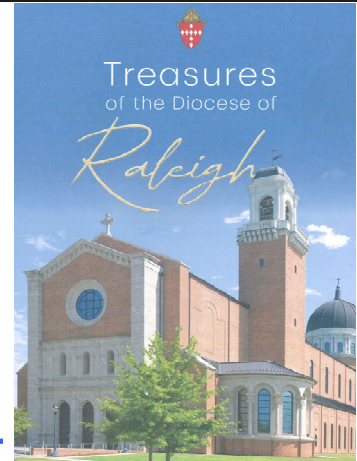
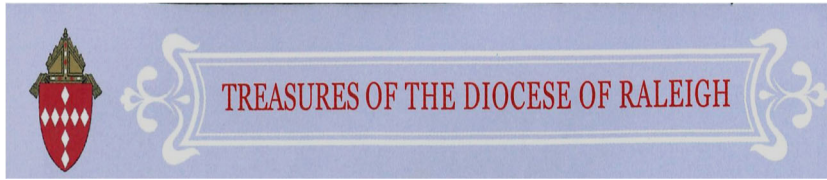

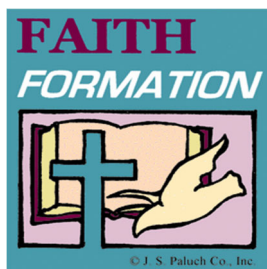
