Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

SAINTS OF THE DAY



Sept 29 Michael, Gabriel and Raphael Archangels; these biblical messengers signify God's transcendence and loving care; Michael means "Who is like God?", Gabriel means "God's Strength" and Raphael means "God's Remedy"; Michael is the patron of security forces and of the sick; Gabriel is the patron of telecommunications and the postal service; Raphael is the patron of travelers and the blind.



Sept 30 Jerome Died in 420 at Bethlehem; devoted monk and ascetic; wrote numerous commentaries on and authored Latin "Vulgate" translation of the Bible; priest; one of the four great doctors of the Latin Church; patron of scripture scholars.



Oct 1 Therese of the Child Jesus Died in 1897 of tuberculosis at age 24; contemplative who urged all to follow "the little way"; proclaimed doctor of the Church; patroness of the missions, of florists and of France; our parish's

patron saint.

Oct 2 The Holy Guardian Angels Observed in Spain since the 16th century. Pope Clement X assigned it to the first free day following Michaelmas Day.



Oct 4 Francis of Assisi Died in 1226; noted for his charismatic personality, deep compassion for all, and love for God's creation; renounced wealth to follow "Lady Poverty"; deacon; founded the Franciscan Family; wrote *Canticle of the Sun*; received the stigmata; canonized two years after his death; patron of ecologists and of Italy.



Oct 5 Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos Died in New Orleans in 1867; born in Germany in 1819; entered the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer and was sent to North America; ordained a priest

in 1844; began his pastoral ministry in Pittsburgh, PA under St John Neumann; dedicated himself to preaching; became a full-time itinerant missionary.



Oct 5 Faustina Kowalska

Died in 1938; venerated as the "Apostle of Divine Mercy"; born in Poland in 1905; in 1928 joined the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy; had visions and conversations with Jesus starting in 1924; in 1931 Jesus presented himself as the "King of Divine Mercy"

wearing a white garment with red and pale rays coming from his heart and she heard him ask her to become the apostle and secretary of divine mercy, a model of how to be merciful to others, and an instrument for emphasizing God's plan of mercy for the world; memorial added to calendar in 2020.

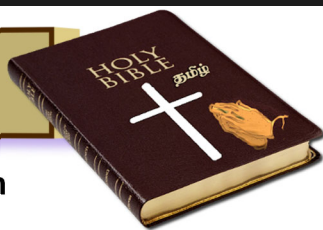

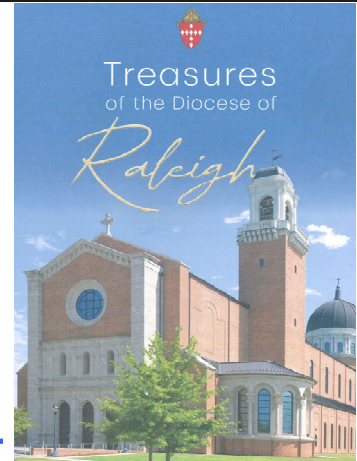
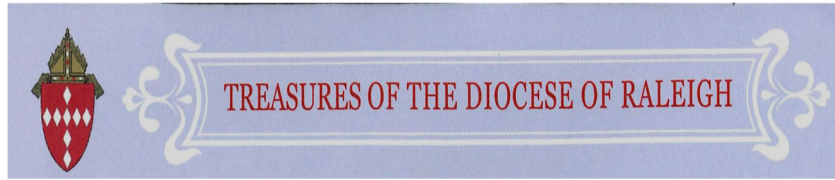


**Courage /

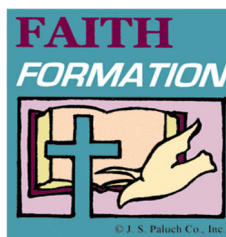
