Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

The scholarships will be presented at the Knights of Columbus breakfast in honor of graduating seniors.



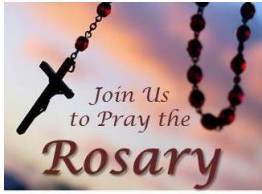
COME TO ADORATION

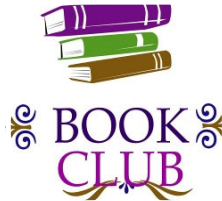

Baptism Preparation Class

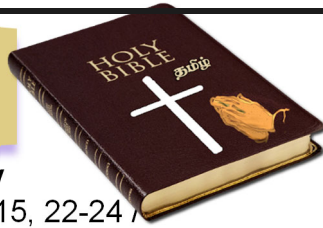

SAINTS OF THE DAY

April 7 **John Baptist de la Salle** Died in 1719; gave away his fortune; found the Brothers of the Christian Schools; authored the *Conduct of Schools*; patron of teachers.

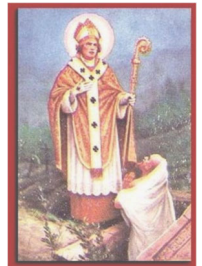


April 8 **Annunciation of the Lord** (is normally on March 25 but this year, because of Holy Week, it was transferred)



First celebrated in the 4th or 5th century, this feast celebrates the angel Gabriel's appearance to the Virgin Mary (Luke 1:26-38), his announcement that the Blessed Virgin had been chosen to be the Mother of Our Lord, and Mary's *fiat*—her willing acceptance of God's holy plan.

April 11 **Stanislaus** Died in 1079; as bishop of Cracow he assisted the poor; personally slain by the oppressive and savage king; patron of Poland.



April 13 **Martin I** Died in 656; as a deacon, served at the imperial court in Constantinople; combated emperor Constans II over Monothelite belief that Jesus had only a divine will and so was not truly human; as pope, forced from Rome to Constantinople where he was tried for treason; later exiled to Crimea where he died of starvation and ill-treatment; last pope to be martyred.

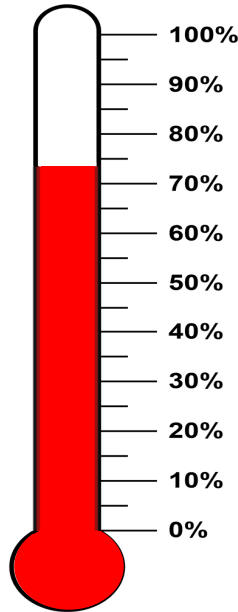
