It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

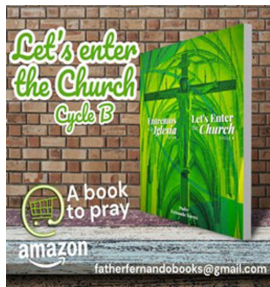


COME TO ADORATION

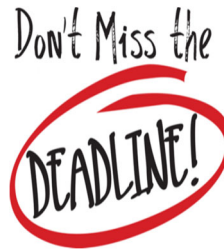

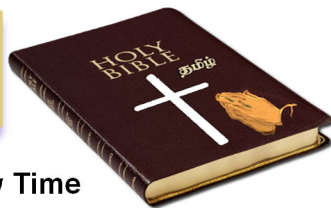

SAINTS OF THE DAY

February 5 **Agatha** Died around 251 in Sicily; patroness of Palermo and Catania; invoked for protection against volcanic eruptions and fires.



February 6 **Paul Miki and companions** Died in 1597; martyr; Jesuit scholastic crucified by order of the ruler Hideyoshi at Nagasaki with 25 others which included 2 other Jesuits, 6 Franciscans, 15 tertiaries and 2 laymen.



February 8

Jerome Emiliani Died in 1537 of the plague; Venetian soldier whose conversion led to the founding of the Clerks Regular of Somascha; dedicated to the poor and the education of youth; patron of orphans and abandoned children.



February 8

Josephine Bakhita Died around 1947 from a long, painful illness; born in Sudan and raised in the Islamic faith; kidnapped around the age of 7 by slave traders; sold to a number of owners until she was purchased around age 12 by the Italian Consul Callisto Legnani; was sent to live with the Canossian Sisters in Venice; was baptized Giuseppina and eventually was granted her freedom; became a Daughter of Charity serving as a cook, seamstress and portress; first Sudanese saint; her name means "Lucky One".



February 10 **Scholastica** Died in 543; twin sister of St. Benedict; invoked against storms; patroness of Benedictine nunneries.

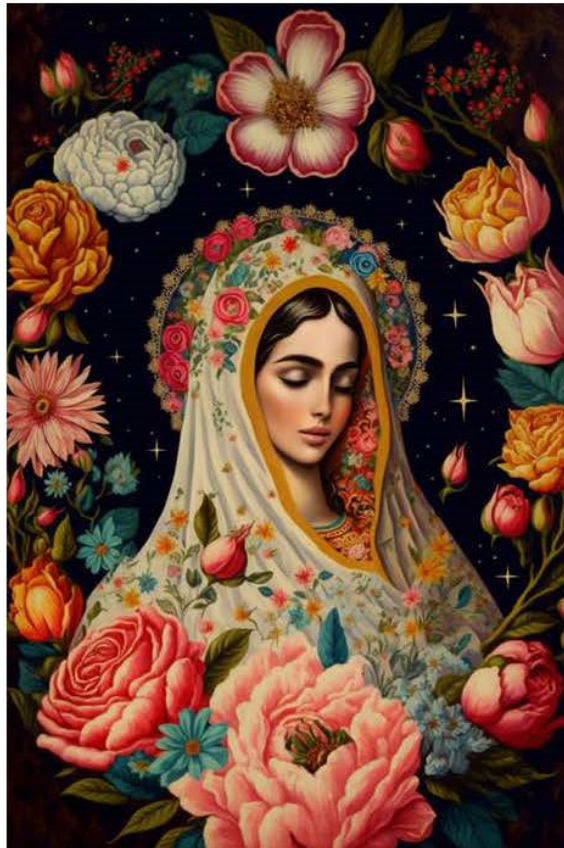

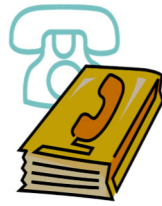

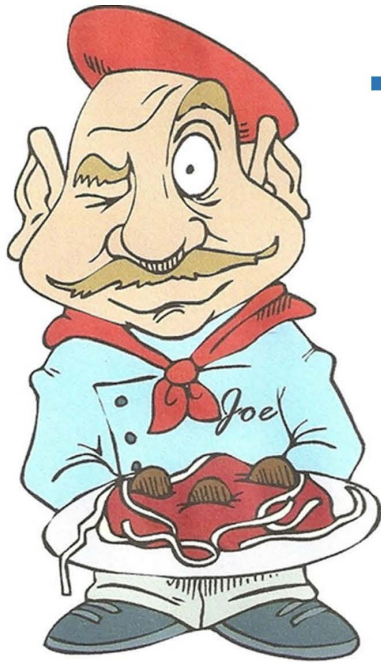
