Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

**Sacrament of Baptism**

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

**Sacrament of Matrimony**

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

**Sacrament of Anointing**

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

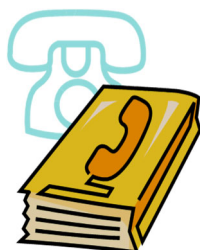

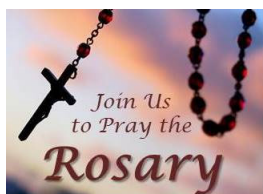


**Cornerstone Charismatic Prayer Group**

SAINTS OF THE DAY

**January 17 Anthony** Died in 356 at age 105; born in upper Egypt; hermit and early founder of religious life; called the “Patriarch of Monks”; aided St. Athanasius of Alexandria in combating Arianism.



**January 20 Fabian** Died in 250; layman elected bishop of Rome in 236; pope.



**January 20 Sebastian** Died around 288; chief of the Praetorian cohort whose *acta* tell of his being pierced by arrows, later being clubbed to death; patron of archers, soldiers and police associations.

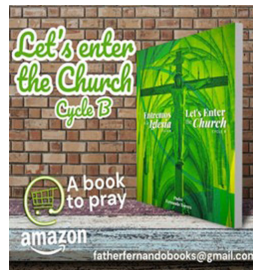

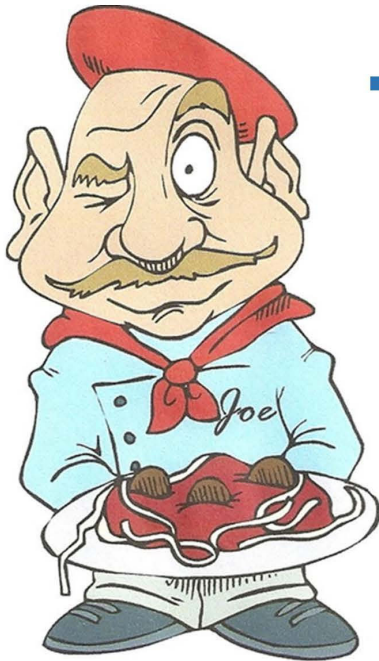
